OBITUARY

Don McCleary

Don McCleary, 47, of Dallas, co-chair of the Human Rights Campaign's board of directors and longtime gay activist, died April 14 from AIDS complications.

McCleary, former manag-

ing partner of the Dallas law firm Gardere and Wynne, joined the HRC's board of directors in 1991 and served as its co-chair since 1994. He helped found the HRC's Federal Club, a major donor pro-

gram, and played a key role in building the organization's presence in Dallas.

He received the Anti-Defamation League Jurisprudence Award and the HRC's Ray Kuchling Humanitarian Award last year, in addition to the Excalibur Award at his law firm for his exemplary contributions — a tribute bestowed only twice before in the firm's 70-year history.

"Don's passing is ... a terrible tragedy for the gay and AIDS communities," said Elizabeth Birch, the HRC's executive director. "Don worked tirelessly so that one day, all Americans will enjoy full equal rights, freedom from discrimination and the unconditional love of their families."

McCleary is survived by his partner, Daniel Pettit; his parents, C.C. "Mac" and Maxine McCleary; and a sister, Carolyn Cassleberry. ▼
