Paul M. Levin

Private unveiling of the tombstone for Paul M. Levin, 38, who formerly owned Paul Levin Construction Co. in Philadelphia, will take place on June 20 in Roosevelt Memorial Park in Trevoise, PA.

A Philadelphia native, Mr. Levin died Jan. 16 in Hospice by the Sea in Boca Raton, FL, of complications from AIDS. He and his lover Lee Smith had moved to Palm Beach, FL in May 1989.

Mr. Levin started his construction business in 1979 following in the footsteps of his father and grandfather, who both worked in construction.

His business did renovation work of businesses and homes in Philadelphia. Prior to starting the construction business, Mr. Levin had owned a horse farm in Coatesville. His crowning achievement was managing a new business for Smith after they moved to Florida. Smith recently sold the business.

In October 1987, Mr. Levin was active as a volunteer in the "From All Walks of Life" walk-a-thon to raise funds for AIDS research. Although he couldn't walk in the event, he did volunteer work and helped find sponsors for others.

Mr. Levin was very close to his parents and very devoted to his mother, Smith said. "She was his best friend at the end."

Besides his life partner, Mr. Levin is survived by his parents, Shirlee and Howard Levin of Boca Raton, and his sister, Randi Bird of Pembroke

Pines, FL. He also was the brother of the late David Levin.

The family has requested contributions in Paul's memory be made to the Hospice by the Sea, 1531 W. Palmetto Park Drive, Boca Raton, FL 33486.

violated the right to free speech because it sought to ban some viewpoints, the court said.

"Whereas the ordinance struck down (in the Minnesota case) was explicitly directed at expression... the statute in this case is aimed at conduct unprotected by the First Amendment," the court said.
