## Harold Daniel Riley

Harold Daniel Riley, of Philadelphia, died May 27, 1993 at his home in Seattle, Washington.

Son of the late Ernestine Byrd-Riley and James Toomer, Harold was born in Philadelphia September 8, 1950, and graduated from Overbrook High School in 1968 where he was an active member of many academic and athletic activities. After a career in dental mechanics, Harold entered the Philadelphia campus of Antioch University and obtained his B.A. in February 1987. While working as a counselor, mental health technician, and case manager at Pennsylvania Institute and other facilities, he completed graduate school at the University of Pennsylvania and received his M.S.W. in June 1990.

Harold's many affiliations in Philadelphia were: Black Alumni Association of the University of Penn., National

Association of Black Social Workers, Al-Anon and Alcoholics Anonymous, and a board member of We The People Living with AIDS.

Harold felt called to move to Seattle in 1990. His last employment was with the Veterans Administration as a therapist for those affected with AIDS. After his illness-related retirement, Harold remained active as a board member of the Seattle AIDS Support Group and its facilitator for people of color. He was also a member of Brother to Brother and Men of All Colors and Cultures Together of Seattle, as well as continuing his commitment to AA and Al-Anon.

He will be missed by his brothers Warren of Seattle, Cecil and Robert of Philadelphia, and sister Joy Perrin Riley-Stephens of Oklahoma City, as well as many other family members and a host of friends from coast to coast.

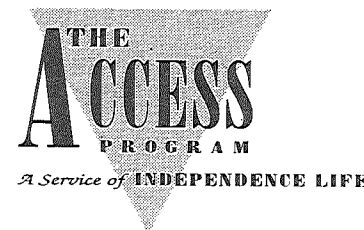
