## Joseph Cappelli

Joseph Cappelli of Narbeth, a local representative to the International Gay Bowling League, died Dec. 28, 1996. He was 42.

Cappelli was an avid bowler for more than 12 years. He bowled in six Philadelphia-area gay leagues, and was a founding member of two of them.

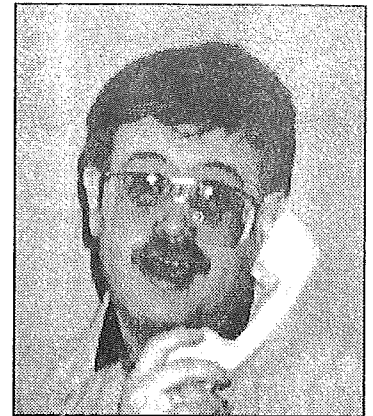
Cappelli held a number of positions in the leagues over the years,

including president, vice president, secretary and treasurer.

In May, he directed the IGBL '96, a tournament that attracted more than 500 international bowlers to Philadelphia.
