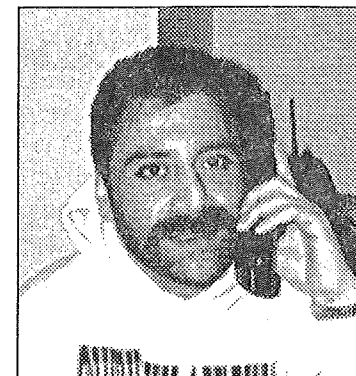

### Frank J. Gotti
