## Michael Parks

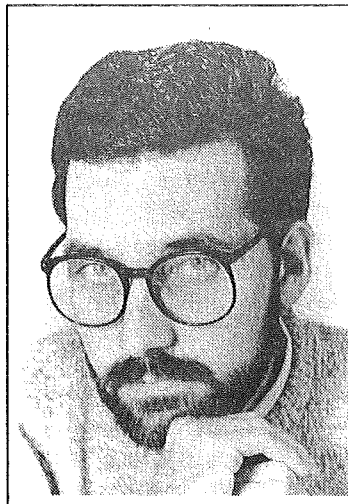
Michael R. Parks, 38, founder of Chamber Opera Philadelphia and a musician and composer whose works were performed by a number of musical organizations in Philadelphia, died of complications of AIDS in Long Beach, California, on Dec. 21.

Mr. Parks, a native of deaborn Michigan, moved to Philadelphia in 1980. His compositions were performed at the Walnut Street Theaer, Trinity Memorial Church, Temple Beth Zikon-Beth Israel, The Stagecrafters, and St. Charles Borremeo Roman Catholic Church.

In 1983, he founded Chamber Opera Philadelphia, and was its artistic director until 1988. The company performed works of Copeland, Mozart, Menotti, and others. Among his compostions performed in Philadelphia were "The Ballad of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde" with librettist Paul Godish, "The Passion of Our Lord" and a Magnificat, as well as many compositions for solo voice.

Before moving to California earlier this year, Mr. Parks was chopir master of St. Charles Borremeo Church at 20th and Streets.

Mr. Parks is survived by three brothers, a sister and a

grandmother. Funeral arrangements are incomplete at this time. A memorial service will be held in Philadelphia at a later date.
